TABLET STUDY:

THE FINAL DRAFT OF THE TABLET MANUSCRIPT IS CURRENTLY BEING REVIEWED BY DR. ROYBAL. ONCE REVIEWED, IF ALL EDITS ARE COMPLETE, WE WILL SUBMIT TO THE JOURNAL OF PSYCHIATRIC PRACTICE FOR PUBLISHING CONSIDERATION.

POLYPHARMACY STUDY:

DR. ROACHE HAS CREATED A SLIDE DECK OF RESULTS THAT HE FEELS SHOULD BE HIGHLIGHTED IN THE MANUSCRIPT. HE IS STILL WORKING ON FINAL EDITS, BUT ONCE COMPLETE, HE WILL SEND TO THE GROUP TO REVIEW. ONCE RESULTS ARE FINALIZED, DR. TIERNEY AND DR. ROACHE WILL BEGIN WORKING ON A MANUSCRIPT.

NEW COVID-19 RELATED PROJECT:

DURING OUR LAST MEETING ON FEBURARY 22ND, WE BEGAN BRAINSTORMING TOPICS FOR A NEW PROJECT. BELOW ARE THE TOP IDEAS THUS FAR:

- PROVIDE PATIENTS WITH A SHORT SURVEY WHICH WILL DETERMINE IF THEY HAVE HAD COVID-19, THEIR EXPERIENCE WITH COVID-19, AND GENERAL QUESTIONS ABOUT THEIR MENTAL HEALTH.
- HAS MOVING TO TELE-HEALTH HAD A POSITIVE OR NEGATIVE EFFECTS ON YOUR PRACTICE AND PATIENTS?
- SURVEY BIOPOLAR PATIENTS TO SEE IF THEY BELIEVE THEY ARE CYCLING MORE OFTEN OR MORE RAPIDLY DURING COVID-19 QUARANTINE. WE COULD DETERMINE IF THERE ARE MORE HOSPITALIZATIONS OR CLINIC VISITS PER PATIENT.
