

Advancing Dissemination & Implementation Sciences Working Group:

Equity-focused Dissemination & Implementation Sciences in Clinical Research, Clinical Practice, and Communities

This NCATS-supported WG leverages CTSA and PBRN models to advance equity-focused D&I sciences across the translational science continuum, increasing impact of clinical and translational research, enhancing healthcare systems, and expanding D&I capacity across the hubs.

The 2023-25 Goals are to

- Advance critical links between research and practice communities by expanding engagement and implementation sciences and defining best practices in Practice-Based Research Networks.
- Build equity-focused D&I capacity among clinical and translational researchers and implementers through consensus competencies, model curricula, and enhanced access to successful programs.

Work is accomplished in subgroups formed around a particular project, such as surveying PBRNs in CTSAs, expanding online resources for accessing D&I training programs, and connecting D&I concepts to learning health systems.
