SCREENING CRITERIA & RISK ASSESSMENT

Are the following statements true for the patient:	
	Admitted to hospital within the last 24-48 hours?
	65 years of age or older?
	English speaking?
	Reachable by telephone?
	Alert and cognitively intact? (see Instruments, SPMSQ >6)
	Documented history of a primary cardiovascular, respiratory, endocrine, or orthopedic health problem?
	Does not have end-stage renal disease?
	Does not have primary neurological diagnosis?
	Does not have major psychiatric illness?
	Does not have a primary diagnosis of cancer?
	Lives within 30 miles of the admitted facility?
	Returning home after discharge (SNF/rehab stay < 3 weeks)?
If yes to all of the above, does the patient have two (or more) of the following risk factors:	
	Age 80 or older
	Moderate to severe functional deficits
	History of mental/emotional illness
	Four or more active co-existing health conditions
	Six or more prescribed medications
	Two or more hospitalizations within past 6 months
	Two or more hospitalizations within past 6 months
	Hospitalization in the past 30 days
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
