RESULTS

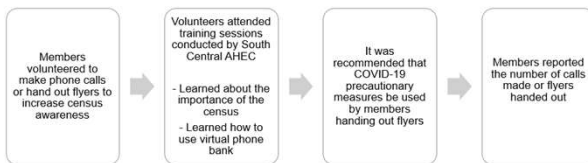
- 483 phone calls were made
