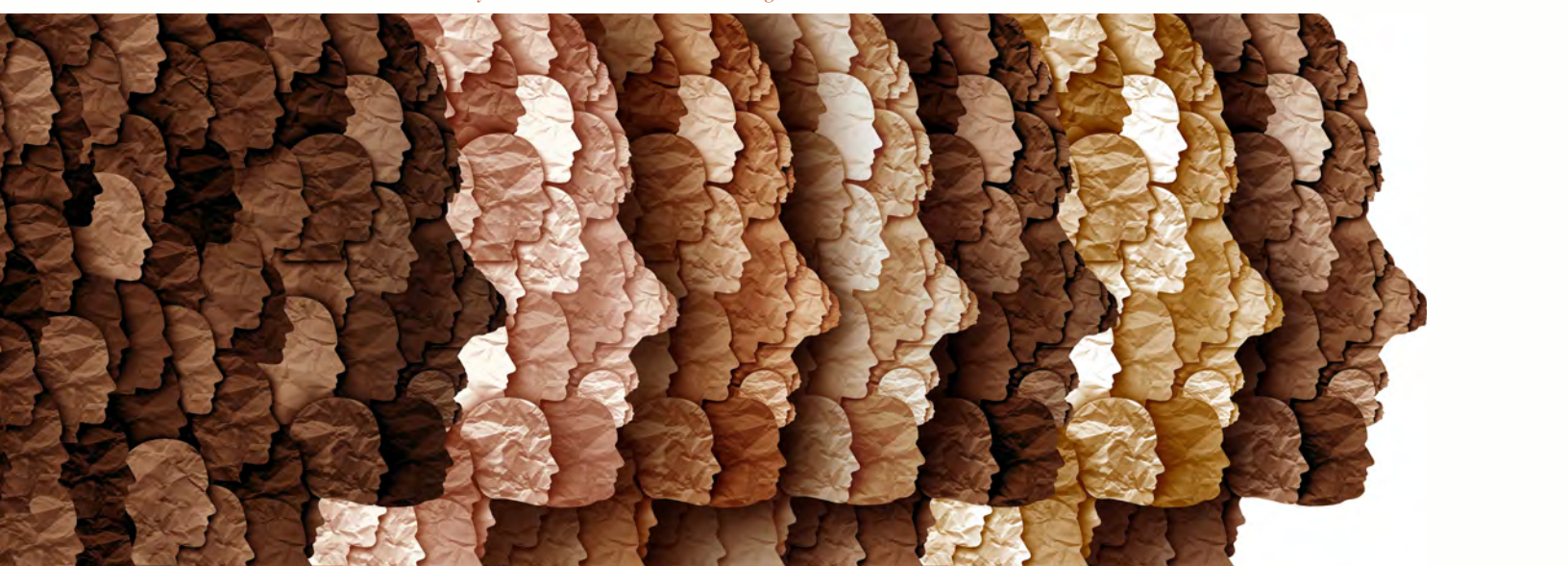

Posters will be judged based on (1) abstract relevance including how the community is or could be engaged in your research; (2) information is presented in a clear and concise manner that is easy for both researchers and non-researchers to understand; and (3) the importance and timeliness of the health research topic and findings to both researchers and the community.
